Our Aim

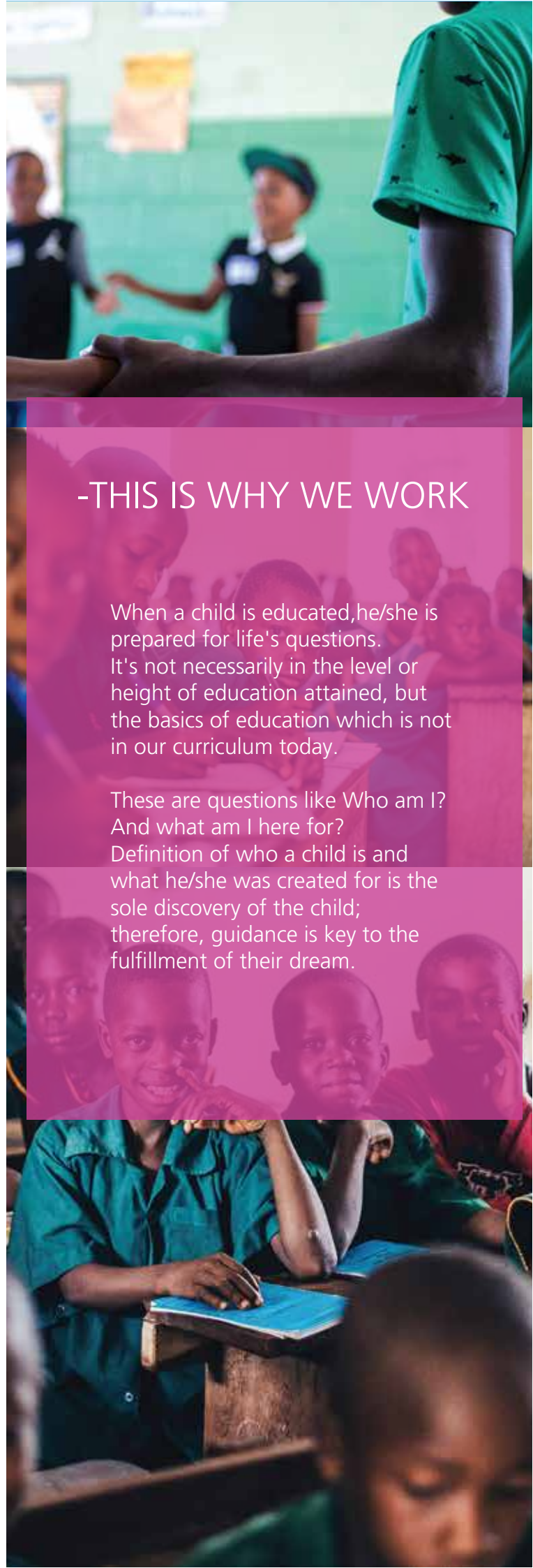

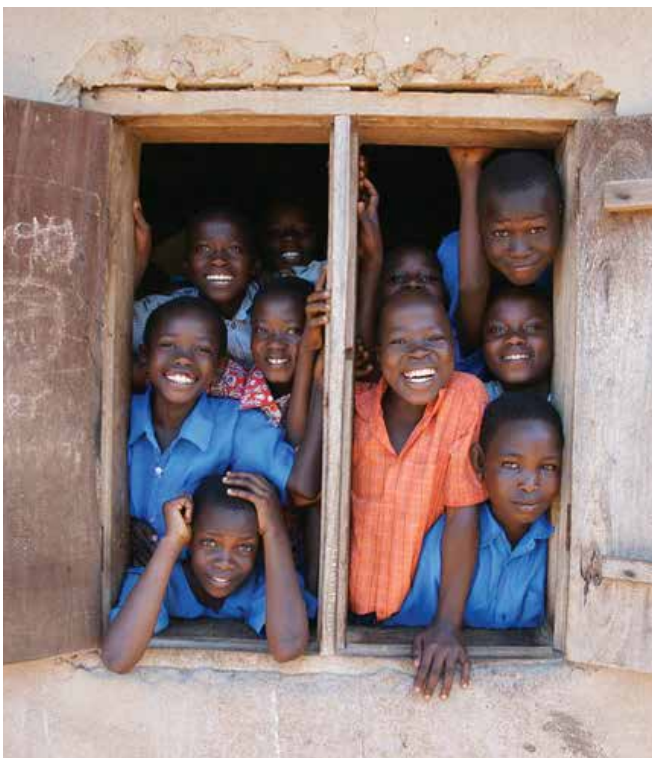
Our Discovery Program
